# UFC: Main representative body of faculty across all EU academic units – Functions:

- Reviews changes in existing policies or the establishment of new policies related to matters of general interest to the University faculty;
- Monitors and reviews the terms and conditions of faculty employment, the state of facilities, policies that affect scholarship and teaching, budgetary commitments, general financial condition of the University, and relationship between faculty & administration;
- Considers suggestions and addresses problems and concerns raised by any recognized faculty group;
- Submits recommendations to the Provost, President or Board of Trustees.

### **UFC** Membership

#### **Voting members:**

20 Elected faculty
 members of the University
 Senate (one 3-year term)

#### **Non-Voting Members:**

- 8 members of the faculty, appointed annually by the UFC EC (up to two 1-year terms);
- EU President; EU Provost (or the most senior officer in Academic Affairs); Chairs of the Standing Committees, ex-officio faculty liaisons to university-wide committees formed by President and Provost; Faculty Counselors assigned to Board of Trustees committees (ex officio members).


