**\*\*Addendum from the Research Impact Survey from Carlos based on questions from last term's meeting:**

Just some data that I wanted to share with you. I pulled out the data from the Impact surveys for the URC program and for the three years from 2018-2020 the total external grant funding that was obtained as a result of the URC program was over \$103M (for less than \$3M investment).
